


## Dear Family & Friends

“Hope Moves Forward.” It is not only the theme of this year’s Annual Report; it is a way of life here at Villa Esperanza Services. Forecasting the needs of our clients and taking action to fulfill them has been key to providing Love, Care and Hope for individuals with developmental/intellectual disabilities for the past 52 years. We believe that each child, adult and senior that we serve should be able to take complete advantage of their capabilities and live full lives as productive members in their community. At every stage of their journey, we provide education, training and support.

This past year has seen many accomplishments. We have increased revenues through program growth and targeted fundraising strategies while decreasing expenses that did not affect the direct delivery of services to our clients. Our advocacy efforts in alliance with other organizations in the Developmentally Disabled Community helped to rescind a 3% funding cut at the state level. Plans for a program to transition our students from school to work have moved ahead. We also initiated action to ensure that this next generation of adults will have appropriate residential options and that adults currently living in our residential homes will have access to increased levels of care as they age.

What may not have been as visible were the collaborative efforts of many individuals directed toward laying the foundation for new and expanded facilities. This includes new buildings for our Villa Street campus and a permanent home for our Dimensions Day Program. Villa’s Board of Directors made a decision in 2012 to move forward with plans to launch a Capital Campaign to fund this project. We believe that our clients deserve an environment that reflects their spirit of growth and achievement. The new facilities will secure Villa’s future as a leader in the field of human services and serve as a landmark in our community.

As we move forward, we continue to focus on strategies that will ensure a continuum of care for each individual we serve, from our youngest students to our active adults to our most vulnerable seniors. **We are truly grateful to all of you who believe in our vision and help us to make it a reality. Thank you.**

## Jamie Henneberry

A primary focus at Villa is to provide services that will help individuals with developmental/intellectual disabilities take full advantage of their capabilities and function as productive members of the community. When an eight year old boy with serious behavior problems started at the Villa Esperanza School thirteen years ago, that might have seemed like a pretty lofty goal. Today, that objective is rapidly becoming a reality for Jamie Henneberry.

Jamie is a unique individual. He's fun, endearing, affectionate and his personality far outshines his disabilities. He is a huge fan of music and movies, capable of replaying scenes out loud at will. For 13 years, he has commuted via taxi with his regular driver, Mr. Rueben, from Manhattan Beach to our Pasadena campus. He sits in the back seat devouring the entertainment section of the LA Times as if he were a movie executive headed to the studio.

During his time at Villa's school, Jamie has been able to make a real shift in the balance between his positive

and negative behaviors. Villa's comprehensive team approach was critical for Jamie's success. The staff worked together to establish an appropriate plan for him and followed up with consistent execution to reinforce it. For Jamie, the team included Speech and Occupational therapists, behaviorists, teachers and a very dedicated one-to-one aide.

In his final year here at Villa's school, Jamie is able to focus and wastes no time getting settled into the classroom and starting his work. When his school year ends, he will most likely transfer into one of Villa's adult programs. He is also transitioning from living with his family to residing in one of Villa's group homes. Jamie's dad relates that a couple of years ago, someone told him that Jamie might be able to have a job someday. He didn't believe it then, but now as he sees Jamie slowly maturing into a responsible adult, it has become a credible possibility and his greatest hope.





## hope moves forward Capital Campaign for **Villa Esperanza**

With the excitement that our founders must have felt 52 years ago on the day they opened the doors of the Villa Esperanza School, the vision of Villa's vibrant new campus and facilities is moving forward towards reality. During the past year, the time and talents of many individuals have been devoted to planning and embarking on a capital campaign to raise the \$9 million dollars needed to complete the first phase of Villa's master plan. The project will include building a new school to replace the current one and purchasing a permanent home for the Dimensions Adult Day Program.

The words most often associated with Villa reflect praise and admiration for the work we do and cite our effectiveness and leadership in the services we deliver. When it came to our aging facilities, the

kindest descriptions were "endearing" and "eclectic." While our campus is well maintained, the mix of old, repurposed buildings represents an earlier era in the history of the developmentally disabled. In the words of Jim McDermott who is the Capital Campaign Co-Chair along with his wife, Cynthia Kurtz, "Our new facilities will be functional and flexible to represent who we are today: open, soaring, light-filled and modern."

The concept that our clients and our staff were deserving of a far better environment became the catalyst for action on the part of two very generous foundations. Leading the charge, the Ayrshire Foundation which is dedicated to "creating opportunities and improving the lives of others," pledged the first \$1 million gift. They were quickly joined by the Wells Fargo Foundation who also made a \$1 million dollar pledge.

Jonathan Weedman, head of Wells Fargo Foundation in Los Angeles stated that the gift to our capital campaign is a response to the "urgent need to renovate the school facilities." Lisa Stevens, Wells Fargo Pacific Midwest Bank Executive added that the two lead gifts "convey the passion and the confidence that everyone in this community has for what Villa has done for over half a century and continues to do."

Villa is very appreciative of our 21 year partnership with Wells which includes the many executives who have served on Villa's Board since 1993 including current board member Joe DeFur and former board member Rich Byrd who is now serving on our Capital Campaign Cabinet. "Wells Fargo's consistency of support is directly linked to the positive impression made by Villa," explained Tim Hanlon who is President of the

Wells Fargo Foundation as well as a member of our Capital Campaign Honorary Committee. 



It's not unusual for a young man in his early thirties to be living out on his own. Nor does it seem out of the ordinary that when his mother comes to visit him at his apartment on a warm day, that he would ask, "Mom, would you like something to drink? I have some apple juice." When she responds affirmatively, he replies, "Would you like some ice in it?" Sounds like a pretty uneventful conversation unless you were familiar with this particular young man and his history.

A year ago, if you said "hello" to Miguel Lambrinos, chances are he would give you a big smile, wave and giggle a little. While he had some speech capabilities, and had received speech therapy many times in his life, he rarely shared his voice.

While visiting Miguel, his father happened to notice that he was exhibiting increased comprehension when seeing words on signs and thought that he might benefit from reading lessons, so Miguel started taking "speech tutoring" lessons at Villa's Speech and Language Center. Working with therapy assistant Barbara Martin, the sight-word based program focused on recognizing functional words in his environment. Miguel was diligent in his lessons and made wonderful progress with his reading skills.

But the big news came when Miguel started speaking. His Villa job coach now describes him as quite talkative, participating in conversations with his co-workers and even initiating them. In another big move forward, he recently relocated from one of Villa's residential group homes to one of our independent living apartments.

So just imagine for a moment that you are Miguel's mom and you are visiting your developmentally disabled son, who rarely speaks, at his own apartment and he's asking you if you want ice in your apple juice. It's not a moment that you would soon forget! For Miguel, it's just one of many more to come.



