VILLA ESPERANZA SCHOOL!

Villa offers a comprehensive range of programs tailored to children with special needs, including the Villa School, Hjelte-Phillips Speech and Language Center, Occupational Therapy Clinic, and Behavioral Therapy. The Villa School serves students aged 5–22 with autism, cerebral palsy, Down syndrome, and other intellectual/developmental disabilities. It features highly experienced and trained teachers providing individualized K-12 instruction and customized education plans for each student. The school's Individualized Educational Programs (IEP) outline specific goals through collaborations among all services, including elementary classrooms (ages 5-10), middle school classrooms (ages 11-14), and high school classrooms (ages 15-22), which teach life, transition, and vocational skills. Classrooms maintain a minimum 1:3 staff-to-child ratio, with one-on-one assistance available as mandated by IEPs. As a non-public school, Villa School receives funding from school district contracts, and regional centers for early intervention services (ages 0-3), and offers private pay options, reflecting Villa's commitment to empowering individuals with special needs throughout their lives.
